

Stronach 5 Rules and Regulations

1. The Stronach 5 is a Pick 5 wager which requires selection of the first place finisher in each of five races held on the same day at one or more racetracks owned and/or operated by The Stronach Group ("TSG"). Participating racetracks and races comprising a given Stronach 5 contest will be selected from time to time by TSG at its sole discretion.
2. The minimum amount for a Stronach 5 wager is \$1 with a takeout rate of 12%.
3. The Maryland Jockey Club will host the Stronach 5 wager and offer the wager as a separate wagering program. The Maryland Racing Commission pari-mutuel regulation .84 Pick (n) rules govern the Stronach 5 wager.
4. A Stronach 5 contest shall be cancelled and all wagers for that contest shall be refunded if three or more of the races included as part of that contest are cancelled or declared a "no contest". If one or two races are cancelled or declared a "no contest", the net pool on the Stronach 5 wager from that day only shall be distributed among the bets which contain the most correct selections for the races which were run, and the carryover pool shall not be distributed; except when there is a mandatory distribution of the carryover.
5. When the condition of the turf course warrants a change of racing surface in any of the races constituting a given Stronach 5 contest, and such change has not been made known to the betting public prior to the close of wagering for such contest, each selection in any changed race(s) on a given Stronach 5 shall be considered a winning selection.
6. Except as provided in section 4 of these rules and regulations, the entire net pool created under a given Stronach 5 contest shall only be distributed on a pari-mutuel basis among those bets which contain all the correct selections; otherwise building a carryover to the next contest. Each subsequent Stronach 5 contest will continue in this manner until the pool created, including the carryover pool, if any, has been distributed; except when there is a mandatory distribution of the carryover.
7. If a dead heat or heats occur in any of the Stronach 5 contests involving horses finishing in, or higher than, any of the places for which this bet is offered, a horse in a dead heat shall be considered as finishing in the position for which it dead heated.
8. If a betting interest is scratched, excused or determined by the judges to be a non-starter:
 - (a) the actual favorite, as evidenced by the amounts wagered in the win pool for the race in which the scratched betting interest was to participate is closed, shall be substituted for that scratched betting interest; or
 - (b) the favorite with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the scratched betting interest if the amounts wagered in the win pool are identical on two or more favorites when wagering on the race is closed.
9. TSG may suspend previously approved Stronach 5 contest wagering with the prior approval of the Maryland Racing Commission.
